

Taking the Sleeping Ban to Court

HUFF (Homeless United for Friendship & Freedom) & HRO (the Human Rights Organization) are planning to take the City's anti-homeless Sleeping Ban (6.36.010a), the Blanket Ban (6.36.010b), and the Camping Ban (6.36.010c) to Federal Court as a violation of basic human rights.



If you have been ticketed
under this law
in the last year, please
contact us.

We'd like to know your name, the date and time of the ticket, whether any shelter was available that night or offered by the police, whether the ticket was done by citizen complaint or officer initiative, which officer gave the ticket, which police agency, and what happened in court (if you went there). Also include, if you know it, the citation number or court case number & a phone number or contact where you can be reached.
